LIGHT-HOUSE FUNDS, CAMBAY ACT No. I. of 1836 (Rep., by Act 17 of 1858)

[4th January, 1836.]

Passed by the Right Hon'ble the Governor General of India in Council, on the 4th January 1836.

B E it enacted, that it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council of Bombay, to employ any portion of the fees levied under authority of Regulation VI. of 1831* of the Bombay Code, for purposes other than those specified in the said Regulation, anything in the said Regulation to the contrary notwithstanding.
*A Regulation for raising at the Ports within the limits of the Gulph of Cambay funds for the support of a Light House upon the Island of Peerim in that Gulph.
