REPEAL BENGAL REGULATION ACT 1842

ACT No. VII. OF 1842

(Rep., Act 8 of 1863)

[19th August, 1842.]

Passed by the Hon'ble the President of the Council of India in Council, on the 19th of August, 1842, with the assent of the Right Hon'ble the Governor General of India.

AN Act for repealing certain provisions of the Bengal Code regarding translations.

I. Whereas the rules regarding the rate of payment for translations of proceedings and other documents for the use of the Civil Courts fixed by Sections V. Regulation XIX. 1797, and Section XXXIII. Regulation IV. 1803, of the Bengal Code, require amendment;-

It is hereby enacted, that Section V. Regulation XIX. 1797, and Section XXXIII. Regulation IV. 1803, be repealed.
