PASSED BY THE GOVERNOR GENERAL OF INDIA IN COUNCIL.

(Received the assent of the Governor General on the 14th January 1870).

An Act to provide Rules relating to Quarantine.

WHEREAS it is expedient to empower expressly Preamble. the Governor General of India in Council and the Local Governments to make rules relating to quarantine; It is hereby enacted as follows :-

1. It shall be lawful for the Governor General of Power to India in Council and (with the previous sanction of make quathe said Governor General in Council) for the Local Governments respectively, from time to time, to make rules

for putting any vessel into a state of quarantine;

for regulating the intercourse of vessels in a state of quarantine with the shore, or with other vessels; and

for regulating the intercourse between ports where an infectious disease prevails and other ports.

2. All such rules shall be published in the Gazette Quarantine of India and also in the local Gazette, and shall thereupon be deemed to be rules made and promulgated under section 271 of the Indian Penal Code.
