

ACT No. VI OF 1870.

PASSED BY THE GOVERNOR GENERAL OF INDIA IN COUNCIL.

*(Received the assent of the Governor General on the
18th February 1870).*

An Act to enable the Governor General in Council to increase the fee payable under section thirty-one of the Emigration Act.

WHEREAS, under section nine of Act No. VI of 1869 *(to amend the law relating to the Emigration of Native Labourers)*, the Governor General of India in Council is empowered to increase any fee payable under sections nineteen, twenty-seven and thirty-four of Act No. XIII of 1864 *(to consolidate and amend the law relating to the Emigration of Native Labourers)*; and whereas it is expedient that he should also be empowered to increase the fee payable under section thirty-one of the same Act; It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. The Governor General of India in Council may from time to time, by notification in the *Gazette of India*, increase any fee payable under section thirty-one of the said Act No. XIII of 1864, and may also in like manner reduce to its present amount any fee so increased: Provided that no fee shall be increased under this section by more than double such amount.
