An Act to provide for the temperary appointment from time to time of an Additional Judicial Commissioner for Oudh.

IN HEREAS it is expedient to provide for the temporary appointment from time to time of an Additional Judicial Commissioner to assist the Judicial Commissioner of Oudh; it is hereby enacted as fol-

1. (1) This Act may be called the Oudh Additional Short title Judicial Commissioner's Act, 1885; and

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. (1) The Local Government may, from time to Appointment time, with the previous sanction of the Governor of Additional General in Council, by notification in the local official missioner of Gazette, appoint such person as it thinks fit to be an Oudh. Additional Judicial Commissioner, and to sit as such in the Court of the Judicial Commissioner of Oudh.

(2) Every person so appointed shall hold his office during the pleasure of the Local Government.

3. Every Additional Judicial Commissioner shall Jurisdiction exercise such jurisdiction and powers of the Judicial and powers Commissioner under any enactment for the time being Judicial in force as the Local Government may, from time to Commistime, prescribe, but only in such cases as the Judicial Commissioner may direct.
