An Act further to amend the Opium Act, 1857.

HEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Opium Act, 1857; It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Opium (Amend-Short title. ment) Act, 1911.

2. In section 3 of the Opium Act, 1857, for the Amendment words "in Calcutta" the words "of the United Pro- of Act XIII of 1857, secvinces of Agra and Oudh" shall be substituted.

3.
