An Act further to amend the Indian Telegraph Act, 1885, and the Indian Post Office Act, 1898.

WHEREAS in view of the amalgamation of the offices of Director-General of Telegraphs and of Director-General of the Post Office of India, it is expedient further to amend the Indian Telegraph Act, XIII of 1885, and the Indian Post Office Act, 1898:

VI of 1898.

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Indian Post Office and Telegraph (Amendment) Act, 1914.

Amendment of sections 3 and in section 29A

29A of Act of the Indian Telegraph Act, 1885, for the word XIII of 1885.

"Telegraphs", wherever it occurs, the words "Posts and Telegraphs" shall be substituted.

Amendment of section 2 of the Indian Post Office Act, VI of 1898.

(i) in clause (a), for the words "the Post Office of India" the words "Posts and Telegraphs" shall be substituted; and

(ii) in clause (k), after the word "department," the words "established for the purpose of carrying the provisions of this Act into effect and" shall be inserted.
