An Act further to amend the Indian Tariff Act, 1894.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Indian Tariff Act, 1894; It is hereby enacted VIII of 188 as follows:—

Short title and retrospective effect.

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Indian Tariff (Amendment) Act, 1917.
- (2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the first day of March, 1917, and any sums due on account of new duties leviable thereunder, or of any deficiency between the duties which have been paid and the duties which are leviable thereunder, shall be deemed to be duties short levied within the meaning of section 39 of the Sea Customs Act, 1878, and that VIII of 18 Act shall apply accordingly.
