An Act to repeal certain provisions of the Indian Criminal Law Amendment Act, 1908.

THEREAS it is expedient that certain provisions of the Indian Criminal Law Amendment Act, XIV of 1908, 1908, should be repealed; It is hereby enacted as follows :

> 1. This Act may be called the Indian Criminal Short title. Law Amendment Repealing Act, 1922.

2. The repeal of an enactment by this Act shall Extent. have effect in every part of British India, including the Sonthal Parganas, in which the enactment was in force at the date of the commencement of this Act, and any notification, made under any law for the time being in force, whereby any such enactment has been declared to be in force in, or applicable to, or has been extended to, any such part, shall on and from that date be deemed to have been cancelled in so far as it. relates to that enactment.

3. Sub-section (3) of section 1 and the whole of Repeals. Part I of, and the Schedule to, the Indian Criminal Law Amendment Act, 1908, and so much of the XIV of 1908. XXXVII1 of 1920. First Schedule to the Devolution Act, 1920, as relates to sub-section (3) of section 1 and to sub-section (1)of section 2 of the Indian Criminal Law Amendment XIV of 1908. Act, 1908, are hereby repealed.
