On the expiration of the Malabar (Completion Appeals to lie of Trials) Ordinance, 1922, and notwithstanding such notwithexpiration, an appeal shall lie to the High Court of expiration Judicature at Madras in any case in which an appeal of Ordinance III of 1922. would have lain to that Court but for such expiration, and every such appeal and every appeal presented to the High Court under that Ordinance before the date of such expiration shall be heard and decided by the High Court.
