

# ACT No. IX OF 1925.

[PASSED BY THE INDIAN LEGISLATURE.]

(Received the assent of the Governor General on the 14th March,  
1925.)

An Act further to amend the Indian Ports Act, 1908.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Indian Ports Act, 1908, for the purpose hereinafter appearing; It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Indian Ports (Amendment) Act, 1925. Short title.

XV of 1908.

2. In sub-section (1) of section 6 of the Indian Ports Act, 1908, after clause (ee), the following clause shall be added, namely:— Amendment of section 6, Act XV of 1908.

“(eee) for regulating the bunkering of vessels with liquid fuel in any such port and the description of barges, pipe lines or tank vehicles to be employed in such bunkering;”
