An Act to amend the Indian Succession Act, 1925, for a certain purpose.

W HEREAS it is expedient to amend the Indian Succession Act, 1925, for the purpose hereinafter appearing; It is hereby enacted as follows:---

1. (1) This Act may be called the Indian Succession short title and commencement. (Amendment) Act, 1926.

(2) It shall come into force on the 1st day of January, 1927.

2. Section 57 of the Indian Succession Act, 1925, shall be Amendment of renumbered as sub-section (1) of section 57, and to that section $\frac{57, \text{ Act}}{1925}$ the following sub-section shall be added, namely :—

"(2) The provisions of section 63 shall apply to all wills and codicils made by any Hindu, Buddhist, Sikh or Jaina on or after the 1st day of January, 1927, to which those provisions are not applied by subsection (1)."
