W HEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Indian Registration Act, 1908, for the purpose hereinafter appearing; It is hereby enacted as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be called the Indian Registration (Amend- short title. ment) Act, 1927.
- 2. In sub-section (2) of section 17 of the Indian Registra-Amendment of section 17, Aot tion Act, 1908, after clause (xii), the following Explanation XVI of 1908. shall be inserted, namely:—
 - "Explanation.—A document purporting or operating to effect a contract for the sale of immoveable property shall not be deemed to require or ever to have required registration by reason only of the fact that such document contains a recital of the payment of any earnest money or of the whole or any part of the purchase money."
