WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Madras
Salt Act, 1889, for the purpose hereinafter appearing;
It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Madras Salt (Amendment) Short title.

2. In sub-clause (4) of clause B of section 43 of the Madras Amendment of
Salt Act, 1889, for the words "five per centum" the words section 43, Mad.
Act IV of 1889.
"such percentage as the Central Board of Revenue may fix"
shall be substituted.
