**An Act further to amend the Sea Customs Act, 1878, for a
certain purpose.**

VIII of 1878.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Sea
Customs Act, 1878, for the purpose hereinafter appear-
ing; It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Sea Customs (Amendment) short title.
Act, 1927.

VIII of 1878.

2. After section 34 of the Sea Customs Act, 1878 (here-
inafter referred to as the said Act), the following section Insertion of
new section 34 A
in Act VIII of
1878.
shall be inserted, namely:—

“ 34A. Where the Customs-collector is satisfied that any Abatement of
duty on goods
on which duty
is levied on
quantity.
goods on which duties are levied on quantity and
not on value, and which are of a kind to which
the Governor General in Council has, by notifica-
tion in the Gazette of India, declared that the pro-
visions of this section shall apply, have before
delivery of the bill of entry deteriorated to the
extent of more than one-tenth of their value, he
may allow an abatement of duty proportionate to
the extent of such deterioration.”

3. In section 35 of the said Act, for the word “ damage ” Amendment of
section 35, Act
VIII of 1878.
the words “ any deterioration ” shall be substituted, and
after the words “ beer, or ” the words “ save as provided by
section 34A ” shall be inserted.
