An Act to amend the law relating to the fostering and development of the steel industry in British India for certain purposes.

W HEREAS it is expedient to amend the law relating to the fostering and development of the steel industry in British India for the purposes hereinafter appearing; It is hereby enacted as follows:—

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Steel Industry (Protec-short title and commencement. 1930.
- (2) It shall come into force on such date as the Governor General in Council may, by notification in the Gazette of India, appoint.

2. In the Second Schedule to the Indian Tariff Act, 1894, Amendment there shall be made the amendments specified in the Schedule Schedule to Act VIII or 1894.
