An Act to amend the Transfer of Property (Amendment) Act, 1929, for a certain purpose.

 - "where the property is not all situated in one subdistrict, or where the registered instrument has been registered under sub-section (2) of section 30 of the Indian Registration Act, 1908, from the earliest date on which any memorandum of such registered instrument has been filed by any Sub-Registrar within whose sub-district any part of the property which is being acquired, or of the property wherein a share or interest is being acquired, is situated "; and
- (ii) in proviso (2) to Explanation I, after the word "instrument" the words "or memorandum" shall be inserted.
