An Act to amend the Cotton Textile Industry (Protection) Act, 1930.

XVII of 1930. **W**HEREAS it is expedient to continue for a further period the protection already given to the cotton textile industry in British India, and for that purpose to extend the operation of the duties imposed by the Cotton Textile Industry (Protection) Act, 1930; It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Cotton Textile Industry Short title.
