An Act to continue for a further period the provisions made by certain Acts for the purpose of fostering and developing the Steel Industry and the Wire and Wire Nail Industry in British India.

WHEREAS it is expedient to continue for a further period the provisions made by certain Acts for the purpose of fostering and developing the Steel Industry and the Wire and Wire Nail Industry in British India; It is hereby enacted as follows :--

1. This Act may be called the Steel and Wire Industries short title. Protection (Extending) Act, 1934.

2. In sub-section (3) of section 2 and in section 3 of the Amendment Steel Industry (Protection) Act, 1927, for the words and figures and 3, Act III "31st day of March, 1934," the words and figures "31st day of 1927. of October, 1934," shall be substituted.

In Item No. 45 and Item No. 46 of the Schedule to the Amendment Indian Tariff (Ottawa Trade Agreement) Amendment Act, 1932, Act XX of for the manufacture (1914) is a first burger of the second se for the words and figures "31st day of March, 1934," the words and figures "31st day of October, 1934," shall be substituted.
