An Act further to amend the General Clauses Act, 1897, for a certain purpose.

HEREAS it is expedient further to amend the General Clauses Act, 1897, for the purpose hereinafter appearing; It is hereby enacted as

1. This Act may be called the General Clauses (Amend- short title. ment) Act, 1936.

2. After section 6 of the General Clauses Act, 1897, Insertion of new section following section shall be inserted, namely:—

1. Insertion of new section 6Ain Act X the following section shall be inserted, namely:

"6A. Where any Act of the Governor General Ropeal of Act in Council or Regulation made after the amendment in commencement of this Act repeals any lation. enactment by which the text of any Act of the Governor General in Council or Regulation was amended by the express omission, insertion or substitution of any matter, then, unless a different intention appears, the repeal shall not affect the continuance of any such amendment made by the enactment so repealed and in operation at the time of such repeal."
