An Act further to amend the Indian Merchant Shipping Act, 1923.

XXI of 1923. WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Indian Merchant Shipping Act, 1923, for the purpose hereinafter appearing ; It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. This Act may be called the Indian Merchant ^{Short title.} Shipping (Amendment) Act, 1939.

XXI of 1923. 2. In section 62 of the Indian Merchant Shipping ^{Amendment of section 62, Act XXI of 1923.} Act, 1923, sub-section (2) shall be re-numbered as sub-section (3) and the following shall be inserted as sub-section (2), namely :—

“(2) The provisions of clauses (b) and (c) of sub-section (1) shall not apply to so much of the wages of a seaman as have been or are hereafter assigned by way of contribution to any fund approved in this behalf by the Central Government, the main purpose of which is the provision of benefits for seamen on retirement ; and the provisions of clauses (a) and (d) of sub-section (1) shall not apply to anything done or to be done for giving effect to such an assignment.”
