## ACT No. VIII of 1940

[PASSED BY THE INDIAN LEGISLATURE.]

(Received the assent of the Governor General on the 11th March, 1940.)

An Act further to amend the Indian Emigration Act, 1922.

VII of 1922.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Indian Emigration Act, 1922, for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

1. This Act may be called the Indian Emigration short title. (Amendment) Act, 1940.

VII of 1922.

2t In section 29 of the Indian Emigration Act, Amendment of section 29, 1922 (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), for Act VII of the words "may be exercised by those officers for the prevention of offences against this Act" the following shall be substituted, namely:—

"may be exercised, for the prevention of offences against this Act, by any such officer, or by a Protector of Emigrants, or a person appointed under section 5".

- 3. To section 30A of the said Act the following Amendment of section 80A. sub-section shall be added, namely:—

  Avet VII of 1922.
  - "(5) If any person commits an offence under this section, any police-officer may arrest him without warrant."
