## THE ORISSA LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY (EXTENSION OF DURATION) ACT, 1966

No. 16 of 1966

[29th May, 1966]

An Act to provide for the extension of the duration of the present Legislative Assembly of the State of Orissa.

Be it enacted by Parliament in the Seventeenth Year Republic of India as follows:-

- 1. This Act may be called the Orissa Legislative Assembly (Exten- Short title. sion of Duration) Act, 1966.
- 2. The period of five years [being the period for which the Legis- Extention lative Assembly of a State may, under clause (1) of article 172 of the of the Constitution, continue from the date appointed for its first meeting] present Orissa in relation to the present Legislative Assembly of the State of Orissa Legislative shall, while the Proclamation of Emergency issued on the 26th day Assembly. of October, 1962, is in operation, be extended up to the 1st day of March, 1967:

Provided that if the Proclamation ceases to operate before the 1st day of March, 1967, the present Legislative Assembly of the State of Orissa shall, unless previously dissolved under clause (2) of article 174 of the Constitution, continue until, six months after the cesser of operation of the Proclamation and no longer.
