THE INDIAN TARIFF (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1975

An Act further to amend the Indian Tariff Act, 1934.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Twenty-sixth Year of the Republic . of India as follows:-

1. (1) This Act may be called the Indian Tariff (Amendment) Act. Short 1975.
