An Act further to amend the Monopolies and Restrictive Trade Practices Act, 1969.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Thirty-ninth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Monopolies and Restrictive Trade Practices (Amendment) Act, 1988.

Amendment of section 22A 2. In section 22A of the Monopolies and Restrictive Trade Practices Act, 1969 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), in sub-section (1), after clause (a), the following clause shall be inserted, namely:—

54 of 1969...

"(aa) which is based totally on technology developed in India;".

Amendment of section 67.

- 3. In section 67 of the principal Act, after sub-section (2), the following sub-section shall be inserted, namely:
 - "(2A) Any rule made under clause (c) of sub-section (2) in relation to the conditions of service of the members of the Commission may be made retrospectively from a date not earlier than the 1st day of January, 1986, so, however, that such rule shall not prejudicially affect the interests of any such member."
