

THE SALARY, ALLOWANCES AND PENSION OF MEMBERS  
OF PARLIAMENT (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1992

No. 3 OF 1993

An Act further to amend the Salary, Allowances and Pension of  
Members of Parliament Act, 1954.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Forty-third Year of the Republic  
of India as follows:—

Short  
title.

1. This Act may be called the Salary, Allowances and Pension of  
Members of Parliament (Amendment) Act, 1992.

Amend-

2. In section 5 of the Salary, Allowances and Pension of Members of  
Parliament Act, 1954,—

(a) in sub-section (2),—

(i) after the words “performed by him”, the words “either  
alone or along with companion or spouse,” shall be inserted;

(ii) in the proviso, for the word “sixteen”, the word “twenty-  
eight” shall be substituted;

(b) after *Explanation II*, the following *Explanation* shall be in-  
serted, namely:—

“*Explanation III*.—For the purposes of sub-section (2), any  
journey performed by the companion or the spouse shall be  
added in computing the limit of twenty-eight journeys specified  
in the proviso to that sub-section.”
